Yalumba was founded in 1849 by Samuel Smith, British migrant and English brewer, who had brought his family to Angaston seeking a new life. After purchasing a 30-acre parcel of land just beyond the southern-eastern boundary of Angaston, Smith and his son began planting the first vines by moonlight. Samuel named his patch "Yalumba" - aboriginal for "all the land around".

Yalumba Wine Company is Australia's oldest family-owned winery. From humble beginnings when founder Samuel Smith purchased a 30-acre plot in the Barossa Valley in South Australia. Five generations and 160 years later Yalumba, Australia's oldest family owned winery, has grown in size and stature, embodying all that has made the Australian wine success story the envy of winemakers the world over.

Yalumba wines have a style all of their own and each have been influenced by a diverse range of elements. Elements Yalumba likes to call 'the controllables', such as the Yalumba Vine Nursery and on-site cooperage - as well as other factors that cannot be emulated by any other winery. Yalumba's history and tradition combined with a reputation for innovation.

The Yalumba Y Series of varietal wines express the lively personality and colorful 150-year history of the Hill Smith family of Yalumba, Australia's oldest family owned winery. These are fresh and flavorsome fruit-driven wine styles of quality and consistency, highlighting the true regional character of South Australia's most renowned viticultural areas and confirming Yalumba's reputation as Australia's finest independent winemaker.

Yalumba Y Series Viogner is a pale gold with green hues. The aroma offers intense white flowers and honeysuckle, with hints of apricot nectar. The palate is rich and very long and ripe, with citrus and tropical fruit flavors.

Yalumba Y Series Shiraz Viogner is bright and youthful. The nose is full of spices, licorice and plum fruits with subtle hints of Viogner emphasized by soft jam of fresh purple grape aromas. The palate is supple, chewy and delicious with sweet vinous fruits and loose-knit tannins.

Yalumba Y Series Cabernet Sauvignon displays exceptional varietal characters, with aromas of briar, black cherry, mint, eucalypt, and violets. These are complemented by hints of cinnamon, vanilla and chocolate. The palate offers flavors of black cherry and cedar wrapped in a medium bodied frame with velvety tannins.
